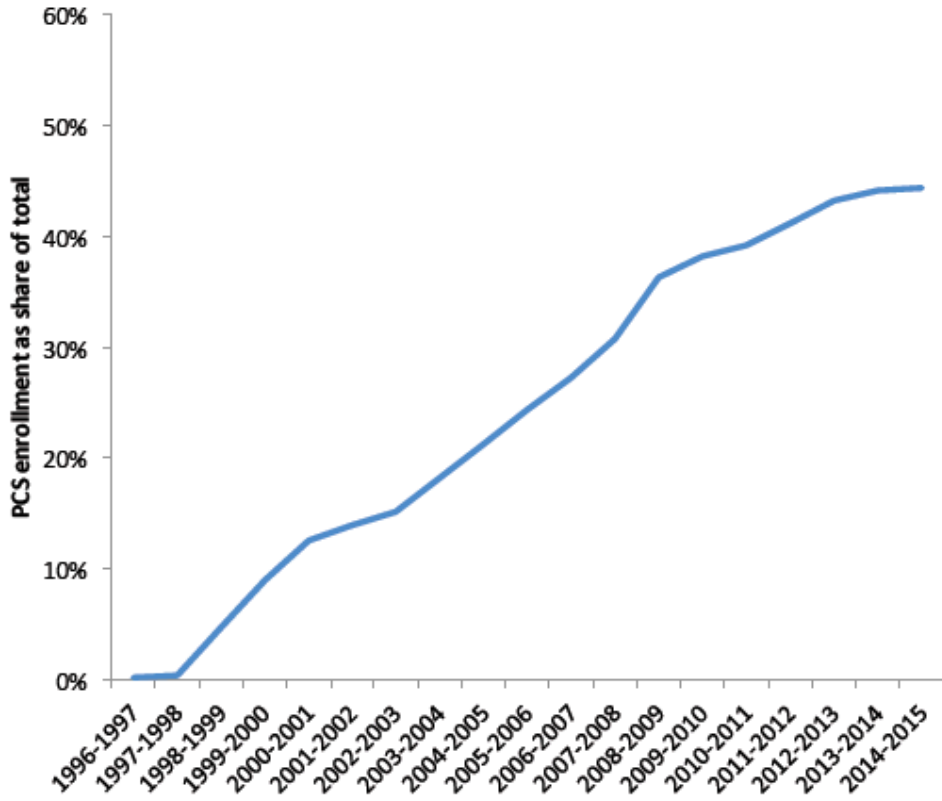

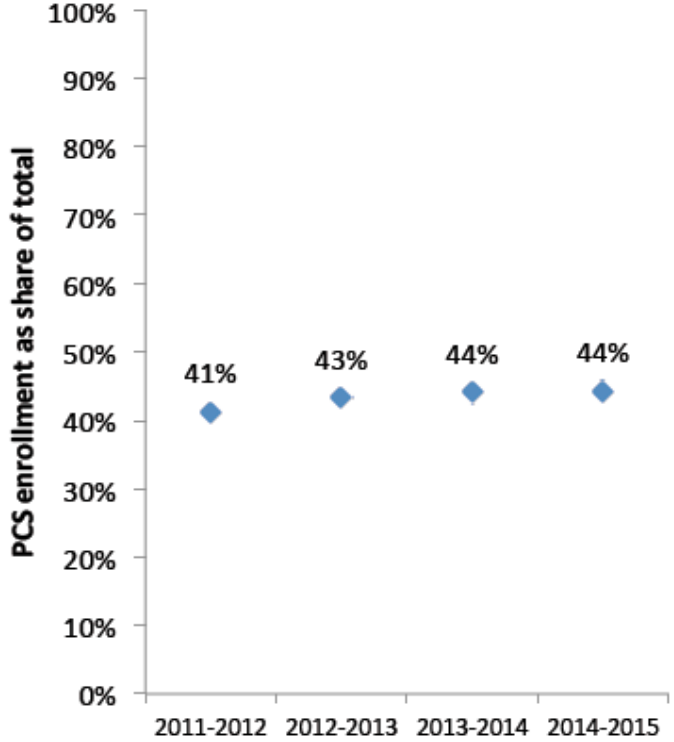
- Charter school quality keeps growing – more students are attending high performing schools

Charter school market share growth over time



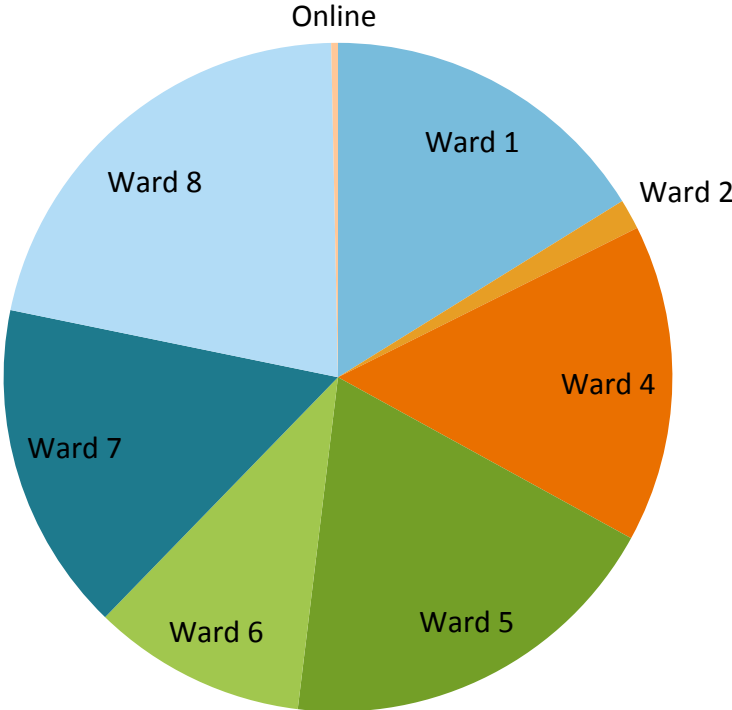
Charter school market share, recent years

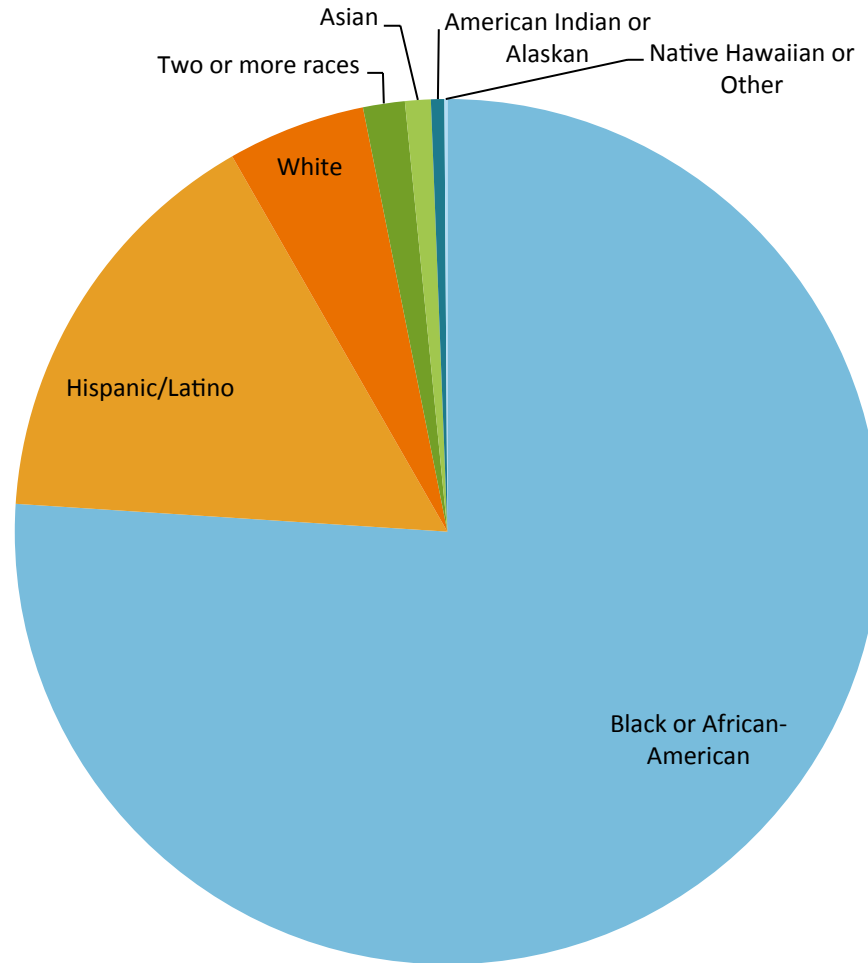

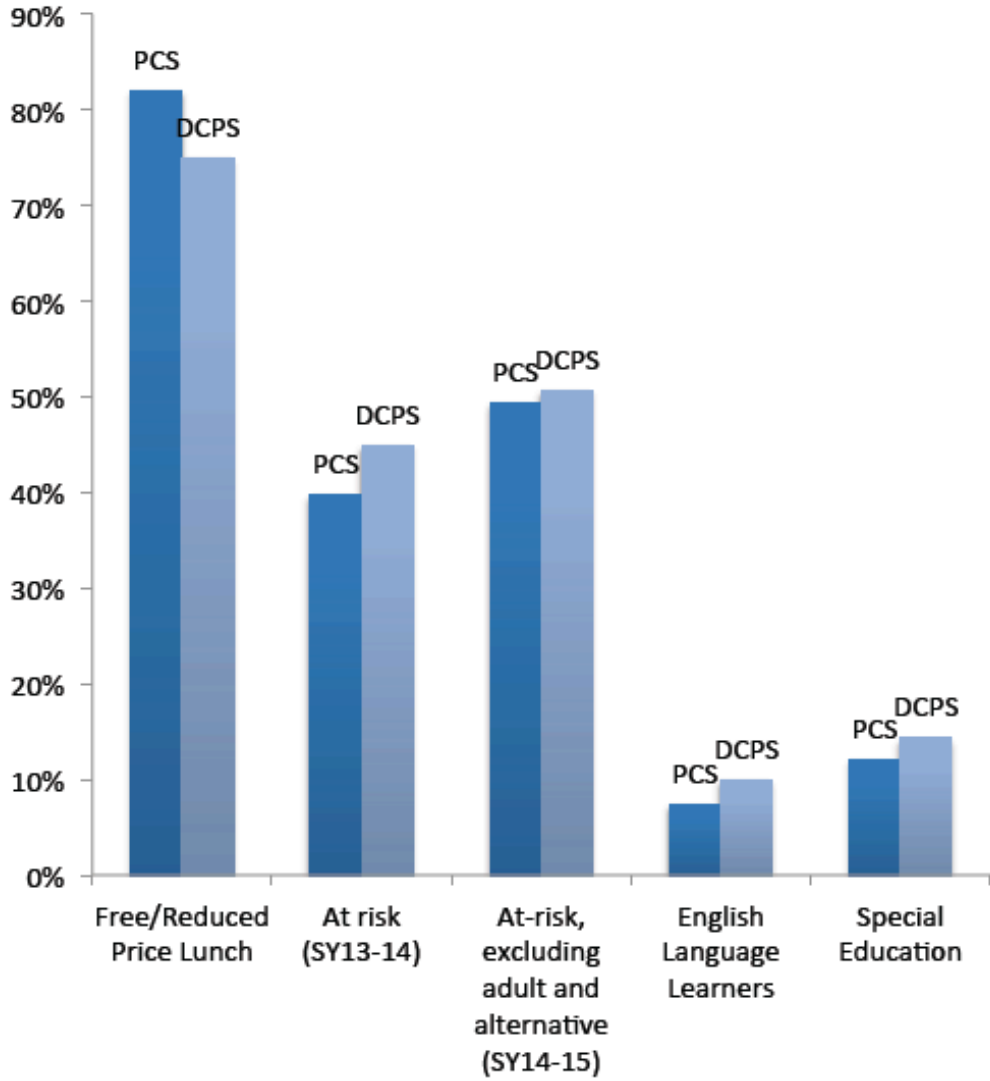

Demographics of charter school students



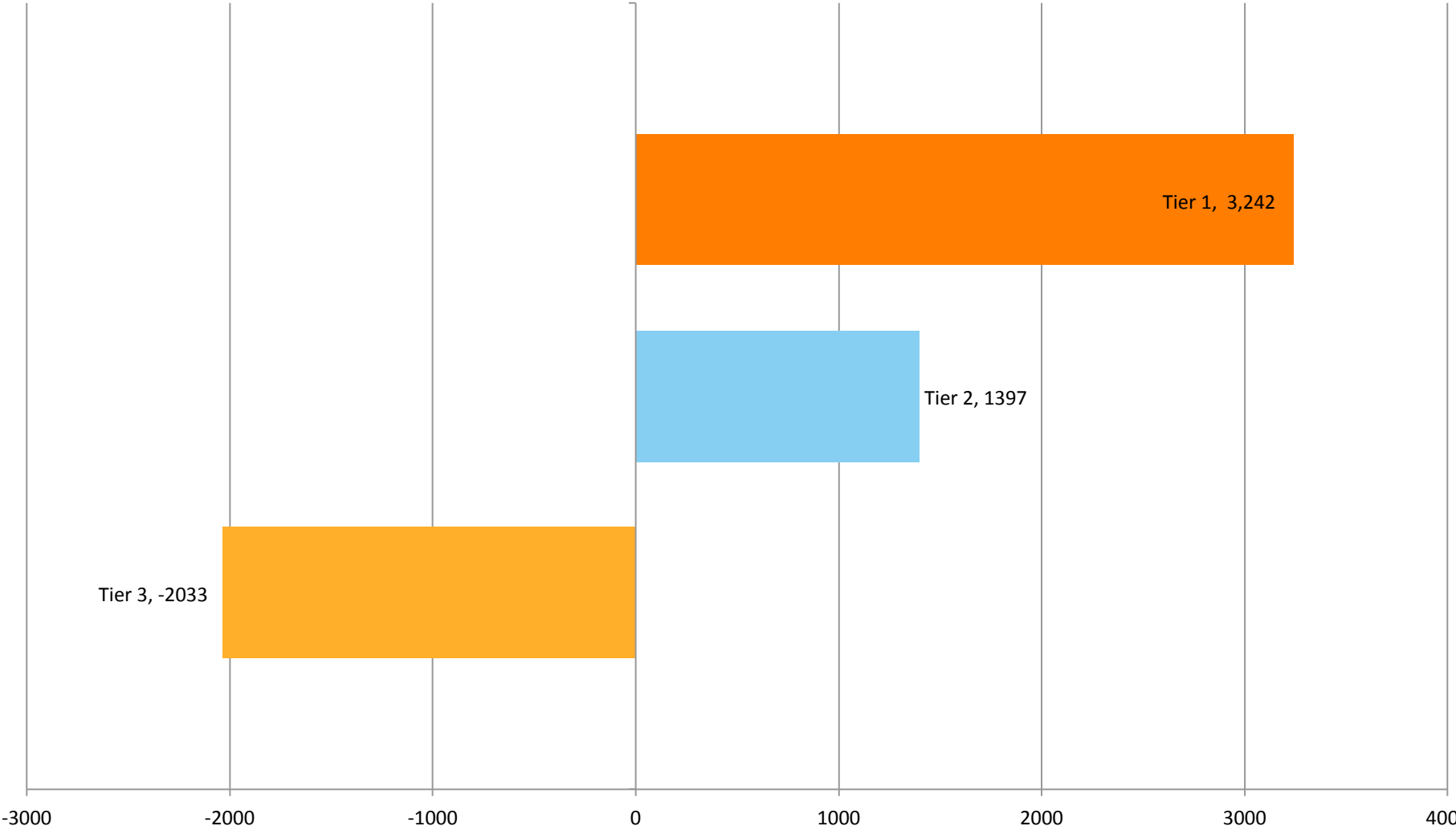
