### **Executive Summary**




- Charter school quality keeps growing – more students are attending high performing schools

- Charter schools serve a diverse student body that is equally or at times more disadvantaged




# Market share growth has stabilized

# Charter school market share, recent years








### % of Enrollment







### **Demographics of charter school students**






