

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) hereby gives notice of a request by The Family Place Public Charter School (TFP PCS) for full charter approval, including its proposed location at TFP non-profit at 3309 16th St. NW. The vote is scheduled for June 25, 2018.

The Family Place PCS received conditional approval to operate a new public charter school on May 22, 2017. Its mission is to "improve the literacy and workplace skills of low-income limited English proficient adults in the District so that they and their family are self-sustaining, employable and engaged in their community." Pending its full charter approval, The Family Place PCS will open in school year 2018-19 and serve adult students aged 18 and over.

- The vote for full charter approval is scheduled for Monday, June 25 at 6:30 p.m. at IDEA PCS at 1027 45th St. NE, Washington, DC 20019.
