

Notice of Petition to Amend Charter: Campus Closure and
Consolidation – **Cesar Chavez PCS**ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: February 25, 2019

**SUMMARY**: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comments on a request submitted by Cesar Chavez Public Charter School for Public Policy (Cesar Chavez PCS) on January 18, 2019 to close the Chavez Prep Middle School campus and consolidate the Chavez Capitol Hill High School campus with the Chavez Parkside campus, both effective at the end of the current school year.

Cesar Chavez PCS is currently authorized to operate grades 6 through 12, and a school may reconfigure its campuses consistent with DC PCSB's <u>School, Campus, and Facility Policy</u>. Further, it is within a school's exclusive control to close campuses. However, a closed campus must also be reflected in a lowered enrollment ceiling for the local education agency (LEA), and all campuses and locations must be reflected accurately in a school's charter agreement. Therefore, the DC PCSB Board must vote on a charter agreement amendment reflecting the revised campus configuration, the single campus location, and the lowered enrollment ceiling.
