

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by AppleTree Public Charter School on March 8, 2018 to relocate its Southeast Campus effective for school year (SY) 2018-2019.

AppleTree PCS-Southeast is currently in its sixth year of operation serving students in grades prekindergarten-3 and prekindergarten-4 at a single campus located in Ward 8. The school's existing facility is located at 2011 Savannah Street SE. Effective for school year 2018-2019 and beyond, AppleTree PCS-Southeast requests to relocate to THEARC, 1801 Mississippi Avenue SE, which is also in Ward 8. There, the school will operate in a new, four-classroom space inside the THEARC facility.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its campus locations.
