Weights

Task Force Proposal #1: Redistribute the weights for student growth and achievement to School Environment

Explanation: Early Childhood Only schools would have slightly less weight in student growth and achievement and slightly more weight in School Environment in CLASS.

Option: Should schools have the option to include K-2 student growth and achievement on scorecard if they use NWEA MAP and end beyond 3rd grade?

Gateway Weight

PCSB Proposal #3– Maintain reduced Gateway weight for schools without PK

To maintain consistency across frameworks, PCSB proposes to lower Gateway for all schools from 15% previously to 10%

Task Force Proposal #4: Consider Attendance & Reenrollment floors and targets by school type

PCSB is researching data on three school types:

- 1. PK-8
- 2. PK-3
- 3. 4-8

If data is consistent across all three, there will be one floor and target proposed for all schools.

- Viewed as a programmatic score
- Minimize concern when hiring new PK teachers

Task Force Proposal #7: K-3 Student Growth

Use national data for 10th and 90th percentiles

Task Force Proposal #8: K-2 Student Achievement

Create similar to PARCC transition floors and

targets

Student Achievement Target: 60th percentile

*Points achieved on NWEA MAP must be similar to points achieved for MGP and Achievement with PARCC

Business Rules

EC Assessments

PK Assessments – Display Only

Display data based on publisher guidance: growth or achievement

K-2 Assessments – Display Only

PMF will display achievement only based on publisher guidance.
 Most assessments have achievement only

Only for schools ending in grades K, 1, 2, or 3

NWEA MAP Achievement

Achievement level: To be set at the 60th percentile with adjusted floors and targets*



Attendance and Re-enrollment

Business Rules:

Floors = calculated based on the lowest 10th percentile of charter school performance over the past three years where the most recent year has 50% weight, the previous year has 30% weight and the year prior to that has 20% weight

<u>Targets</u> = calculated based on the 90th percentile of charter school performance over the past three years where the most recent year has 50% weight, the previous year has 30% weight and the year prior to that has 20% weight

*If the range between the 10th and 90th percentiles is less than 10, we take the 90th percentile and subtract 10
