



Notice of Petition to Amend Charter:
Goals and Academic Achievement Expectations – Cesar Chavez PCS

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **August 2, 2017**

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("DC PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request submitted by Cesar Chavez Public Charter School for Public Policy ("Cesar Chavez PCS") on June 20, 2017 to amend its goals and academic achievement expectations.

Currently in its nineteenth year of operation, Cesar Chavez PCS serves students in grades 6-12. The school will be up for its 20-year review in 2018. Effective immediately, the school would like to amend its goals and academic achievement expectations to adopt DC PCSB's Performance Management Framework as its performance targets.

Pursuant to the School Reform Act, D.C. Code 38-1802 et seq., a charter school must submit a petition to revise its charter, which includes its goals and academic achievement expectations.
