Attendance and Truancy Report
SY 2015-16



Summary

At DC PCSB, we are committed to ensuring schools and students have the information and resources needed to provide students with a quality education to help them learn and thrive. Attendance is a vital component of academic growth and well-being of students. Pursuant to the reporting requirements outlined in DC Code § 38-203, we work with public charter LEAs to track student attendance to publish an annual report. The below report outlines disciplinary trends including suspensions, expulsions and truancy in the previous school year's data.

During SY 2015-16, public charter schools saw suspensions and expulsions decrease and in-seat attendance increase. Out of school suspensions dropped to 9.1%, down from 10.9%. This marks the fifth consecutive year of a positive trend on these measures. The truancy rate rose from 18.6% to 19.8% during the last school year due to a change in business rules. Applying the old business rules, the truancy rate would have slightly decreased from 14.7% to 14.5%. Under the old business rules, truancy numbers did not exclude students younger than 5 (as of Sept 30) or 18 years+. Under the new rules, students not of compulsory age are omitted from the sector wide denominator.

We're committed in working with schools to ensure a reduction in the truancy rate. Our analysis shows there is a strong correlation between inseat attendance and academic achievement. We believe it is imperative students attend school to unlock their full potential. Moving forward, we will continue to work with the Office of the State Superintendent and LEAs to refine and to enhance our best practices around discipline and truancy data.





SY 2015-16 Charter Sector Average : 9.1%* (down from 10.9% in SY 2014-15)







Our Role in Addressing Discipline

- DC PCSB assess discipline policies when new applicant groups apply for a charter
- When schools are up for charter review, we work with the schools on revising charter goals, including goals around discipline
- Schools' discipline policies are posted on DC PCSB's website in each school's Student Handbook. All must have the following:
 - Clear explanation of infractions, consequences and due process
 - Explanation of disciplinary steps for students with disabilities
- We analyze discipline data monthly to look for trends, and alerts schools when they are an outlier with their rate of disciplinary incidences.




