DC PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL BOARD'S MISSION AND VISION

Mission: To provide quality public charter school options for DC students, families, and communities through:

- A comprehensive application review process
- Effective oversight
- Meaningful support
- Active engagement of its stakeholders

Vision: To lead the transformation of public education in DC and serve as a national role model for charter school authorizing and accountability.

WHAT IS A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL?

PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS

Like traditional schools run by DC Public Schools, public charter schools are public, tuition-free, and open to all.

Both traditional and public charter schools are committed to quality education. Where they differ is that traditional schools are run by a central authority – the chancellor of DC Public Schools.

In contrast, public charter schools are run by nonprofits, under agreements approved by the DC Public Charter School Board.

QUALITY

At public charter schools, students can excel academically and mature emotionally. They help students learn and grow. Public charter schools support students to be their best, to work in teams, and to gain the skills they will need to do well in life.

CHOICE

Choice means that families can pick from dozens of unique public charter schools, which offer new, innovative, and different approaches to learning.

Some employ very structured educational environments. Others focus on language immersion, blended learning, Montessori, expeditionary learning, adult education programs, and more.

TUITION-FREE

Public charter schools are free to attend. Like other public schools, they receive funding from the city. Families do not pay tuition.

WHERE DO THEY COME FROM?

Public charter schools are started by nonprofits that apply for a school charter through the DC Public Charter School Board. Although each school's mission may vary depending on its academic focus area, all public charter schools must demonstrate academic success.

DEBUNKING MYTHS ABOUT DC'S PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOLS

Myth #1: Public charter schools are private schools.

Fact: Public charter schools are public schools and are

open to all students free of charge.

Myth #2: Public charter schools "cherry pick" students.

Fact: Public charter schools cannot select their students.

All students may enroll. If too many students apply,

admission is by random lottery.

Myth #3: Public charter schools are not held accountable by anyone.

Fact: Each public charter school is run by a DC nonprofit

and their financials are publicly available. All DC public charter schools are **held accountable by the**

DC Public Charter School Board to ensure that

students receive a **quality** education.

Myth #4: All public charter schools are the same.

Fact: No public charter school is the same as any other

public charter school. Each offers innovative

programs ranging from language immersion to

Montessori, to adult literacy, and much more.

HOW DO I FIND A SPACE FOR MY CHILD?

DC public charter schools are public and tuition-free, open to all students, and they do not have selective entrance requirements. They offer District families a wide variety of quality educational choices. They are independent from the traditional public school system. The DC Public Charter School Board provides oversight but does not manage the schools. The Board uses the School Quality Reports to rate a public charter school's academic performance, and places each public charter school in one of three performance tiers: Tier 1 (high performing), Tier 2 (mid performing), or Tier 3 (low performing).

Families should complete a My School DC application to request space at participating public charter schools.

MY SCHOOL DC

My School DC is a common application and a common lottery for public charter schools and DC Public Schools (DCPS). Starting December 12. families can access the common application at MySchoolDC.org.


