

## Revisions of DC PCSB's Enrollment Ceiling Increase Policy

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: **April 23, 2018 (or date of public hearing)** 

**SUMMARY**: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("DC PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on revisions to the Enrollment Ceiling Increase (ECI) Policy. The policy is being revised to clarify standards DC PCSB will consider when determining whether a school will be granted an ECI, and to ensure the Board's practices and the policy are aligned. New criteria introduced into the policy includes: standards for community engagement, subgroup performance or growth on the state assessment, and exclusionary discipline.
