

Notice of new DC PCSB Policy: Credit Recovery Policy

ACTION: Open for Public Comment

PUBLIC COMMENT ACCEPTED UNTIL: March 19, 2018

SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board ("DC PCSB") announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on the Credit Recovery Policy from February 7 to March 19, 2018.

This policy outlines DC PCSB's requirements for credit recovery policies. It clarifies that each policy must include eligibility for participation, how students are referred or assigned to credit recovery, where and when credit recovery courses take place, and how credit recovery credits are earned. It also requires that any credit recovery program must be determined by the school to incorporate the essential learning elements of the underlying course for which it provides credit.

- Comments must be submitted on or before March 19, 2018.
