



# Attendance and Discipline Report SY 2022-23

## Summary

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Each year, the DC Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) works with the Office of the State Superintendent (OSSE) and public charter local education agencies to track student attendance and disciplinary measures pursuant to the reporting requirements outlined in DC Code § 38-203(i). These measures are significant indicators of the learning environments public charter schools provide and the atmosphere students experience.

The following report outlines trends in suspensions, expulsions, truancy, and attendance for the 2022-2023 school year. This school year was the first since school year (SY) 2018-19 that there were few disruptions to learning as a result of COVID-19. Schools did not need to pivot to virtual learning in response to spikes in infections in the community or outbreaks in classrooms. This report is also the first in a number of years in which we can compare two consecutive years of data.

In SY21-22, rates of out of school suspensions and expulsions were at their lowest they had been in a decade outside of the years of partial or fully virtual learning. While these rates rose for a second year, in SY22-23, the rates are lower than they were in SY13-14 through SY16-17. The public charter sector continues to minimize the use of these consequences in favor of more restorative practices.

The sector experienced a dramatic improvement in truancy in SY22-23. In SY21-22, the truancy rate was 44.3% which declined to 27.0% this past school year. In the prior school year, the impacts of COVID-19 continued to hamper attendance. Some barriers to attendance included illness of family members, parental fear of sending kids to school amidst news of COVID-19 surges, and logistical difficulties involving siblings when one was quarantined at home and the other was expected to be in school. In SY22-23, many of those challenges were no longer as significant which meant many more students were able to regularly attend school and receive consistent instruction. The improvement is also a testament to schools supporting students and families with attendance and implementing effective strategies to decrease truancy.

We were pleased to see the in-seat attendance (ISA) rate increase from 85.0% to 85.6% in SY22-23. While ISA is still below pre-pandemic levels, we know schools are taking many steps to continue to move the rate in a positive direction. Schools used wake up calls, personalized attendance plans, and transportation supports in addition to other strategies to work with families to improve attendance.

DC PCSB is eager to see schools' attendance rates rise above pre-pandemic levels. We will continue to engage schools and implement interventions as needed. Further, our staff is revising our accountability framework and we intend to incorporate attendance into the framework.

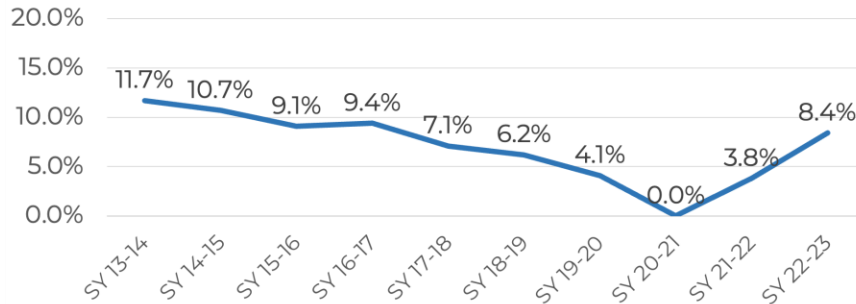

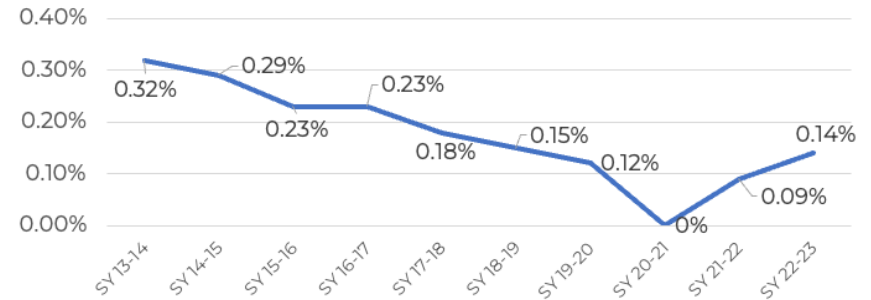

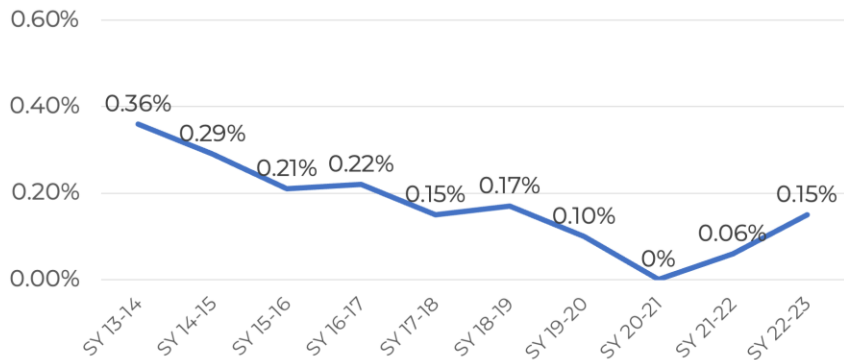
Out of School Suspensions (OSS) Rate



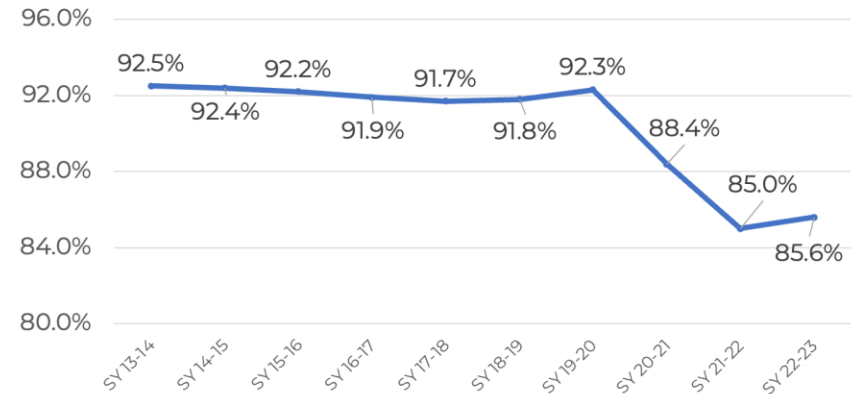
Lost Instructional Time due to OSS



Expulsion Rate



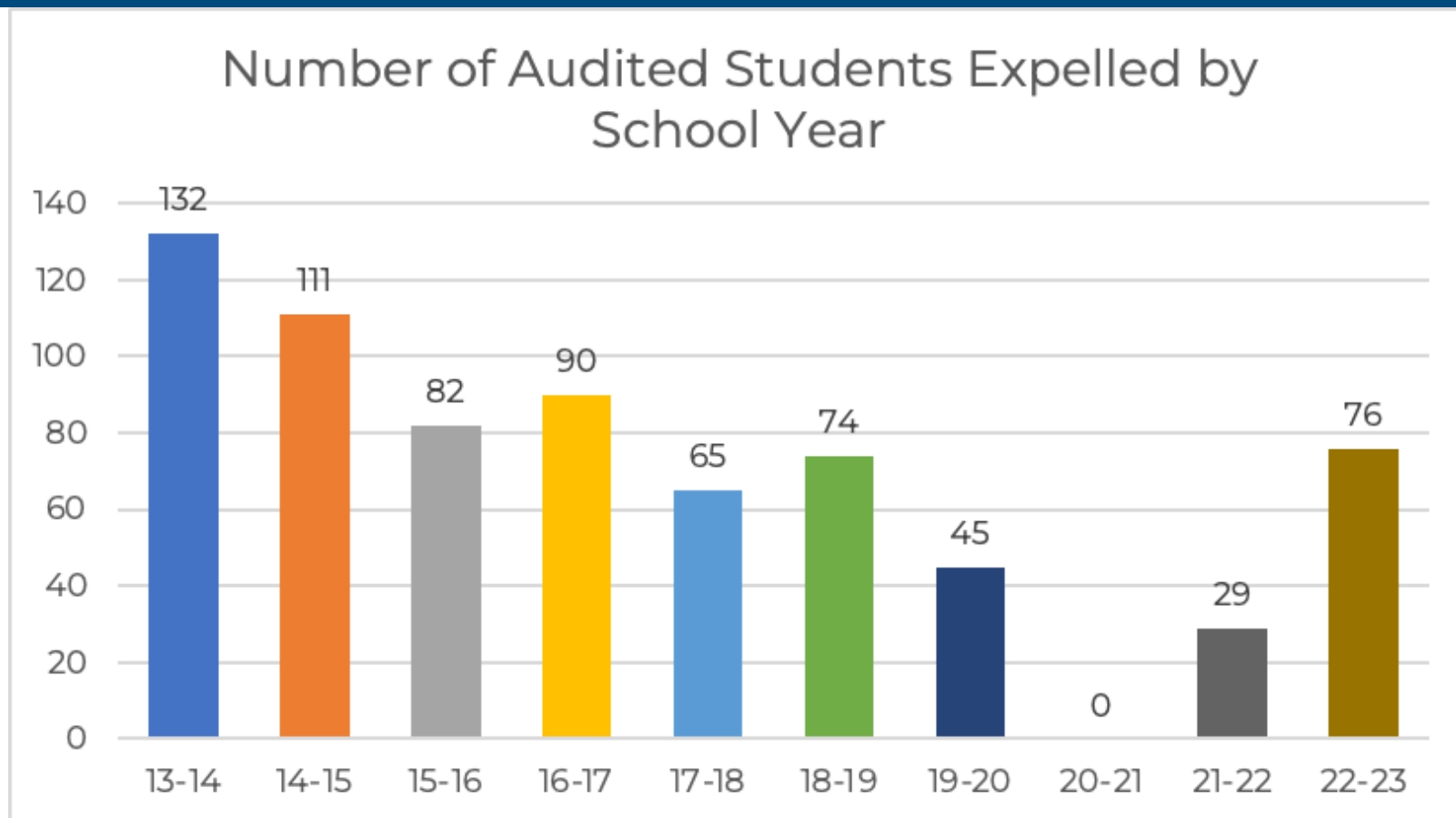
In Seat Attendance (ISA) excluding Adult campuses

# Key Takeaways: SY 2022-23 vs. SY 2021-22

Comparing SY 2022-23 to SY 2021-22 shows the following trends. Broadly, attendance measures improved from SY 2021-22, while discipline measures declined.

- **Enrollment:** ↑ by **3.6%** (44,765 to 46,358)
- **Suspensions:** ↑ from **3.8%** to **8.4%**
- **Expulsions:** ↑ from **0.06%** to **0.15%**
- **Lost Instruction Time:** ↑ from **0.09%** to **0.14%**
- **In Seat Attendance (PK-12 only):** ↑ from **85.0%** to **85.6%**
- **Truancy (students age 5-17 only):** ↓ from **44.3%** to **27.0%**
- **Chronic Absenteeism (PK-12 only):** ↓ from **53.2%** to **52.2%**

# Attendance Referrals

## Court Social Services and Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) Referrals (Self-Reported Data)

- 3,545 students (ages 5-13) were referred for truancy to the DC Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA).
- 726 students (ages 14-17) were referred for truancy to DC's Family Court Social Services Division (FCSSD).

## **Student Support Team (Self-Reported Data)**

- 8,801 DC charter school students met with a Student Support Team (SST), or its equivalent, for attendance purposes in SY 2022-23.



# Strategies to Improve Attendance

## **Strategies implemented by SSTs to improve attendance (varies by school)**

- Wake-up phone calls
- Targeted communication with parents (e.g., letters, emails, phone calls, texts)
- Broad communication with parents (e.g., newsletters, parent/community seminars to discuss attendance policies)
- Parent-teacher conferences (in person and virtual)
- Attendance check-ins with school leaders and attendance coordinators
- Personalized attendance plans
- Safety and wellness checks; home visits
- Attendance incentives: rewards; care packages (e.g., personal items, food)
- Technology support
- Transportation support (e.g., rideshare gift cards, personalized transportation schedules, coordinating carpools among families, free before/after care, connection with other childcare services)



# Services Used and Barriers to Attendance

## **Services most used to reduce unexcused absences (varies by school)**

- Free before/after care services, Mary's Center support services, incentives provided by Boys Town, CFSA support, student and parent attendance contracts, Show Up Stand Out (SUSO), Department of Behavioral Health services, counseling services, Kids Ride Free

## **Common barriers to implementing the recommendations of the SST (varies by school)**

- Lack of responsiveness from parents/guardians, access to technology and internet, access to safe/quiet learning environments, frequently changing addresses and phone numbers, unpredictable family work schedules, unmet mental/physical health needs, lack of childcare, access to safe housing, transportation, Covid-19, safety concerns, student engagement in SST intervention
