#### School Updates

Fewer staff transitions this year than last

Enrollment: as of this date, 493 of 496 seats filled; Lower school is at 100%, Middle School is at 98%; 23 students in the rising 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> transitioned to new schools. We are instituting a New Family Orientation for the 19-20 school year Staff members will attend the Columbia University Teachers College Readers and Writers Workshop, Responsive Classroom and Restorative Justice training this summer

Professional development for teaching teams will be more specific in the coming school year with a school-wide focus on instructional planning, behavior management, social and emotional learning

The focus on prevention of suspension will include consideration of proactive measures and connecting to mental health services
