Opening

Ms. Mahony called the meeting to order at 6:09pm.

Approval of Board Meeting Minutes

Ms. Mahony asked board members if there were any additions or corrections to the minutes of the September board meeting. There being none, Ms. Mahony asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Mr. Nellhaus so moved, and Ms. Taylor seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

CEO's Report

Dr. Wright provided the board with an update around Paul's three-year Strategic Plan that was created in and has been in effect since 2018, and her plan to modify these goals to be more aligned with our progress thus far. Dr. Wright spoke about each goal, highlighting the needs behind each shift. The changes to the Strategic Plan have already been reviewed by the School Performance Committee.

In order to achieve the updated goals, Ms. Spann explained that more data driven decision making and close monitoring of systems of progress (that were in place during year one of the strategic plan), is the organization's priority. For example,

Mini-PMF Taskforce groups have been established for each of the PMF metrics, and data is reviewed on a biweekly basis. Additional routes include the implementation of clear expectations of small group instruction, beginning PARC Prep courses at the beginning of the school year, and offering content specific professional development opportunities.

Dr. Wright shared proposed the following shifts to the 2019 goals from the Strategic Plan:

Treasurer's Report

Mr. Henderson reviewed the Key Performance Indicators from the September financial materials. We are now at 756 enrolled students, which is higher than what was originally budgeted for. Mr. Fine explained that most of the extra revenue available was needed to better service the Special Education department. The financials for the next few months should be relatively stable and predictable, and the CapEx plan for the next year will be discussed within the Finance Committee in the coming months.

New Business

Ms. Mahony informed the board of the compliance requirements monitored by PCSB, and our subsequent need for an additional board member. She briefly reviewed the

qualifications of the current candidates and explained the nomination process managed by the Governance Committee. The new board member will be voted upon in November. It was also decided that the November board meeting should be held virtually on November 19, 2019 in light of the holiday.
