II. **Audit/Finance Updates:**

HCPCS/Board

- **Enrollment Audit:**
 - 1. Total student enrollment on Count Day was 712 Students Total (Don mentioned).
 - Our sub-groups and At-Risk designation may fluctuate. We will be notified about any changes January 15th when the per pupil payment arrives.
 - 3. Two-3 staff vacancies are off-setting some of the revenue loss.
 - 4. Operations Director has not been hired yet.
 - 5. Sade has picked up overseeing enrollment and the NSLP two areas of significant risk
 - Enrollment residency issues have been cleared
 - Imagine has contracted with EdOps to manage some of the student data via PowerSchool

School Updates III.

- Tolson:
 - 1. Literacy mid-term goals were not met: Strategic SST time along with the leveled reader program have been implemented to target this issue.
 - 2. Data conferences have been implemented for each student.
 - 3. Class dojo has been marketed to parents and signups are increasing.
 - 4. New middle school math program has begun.
 - 5. Early Childhood educators have been receiving ongoing professional development
 - 6. Goal for all E.C. teachers to be CLASS certified.
 - 7. Middle school team and the lead counselor work with High Schools for student placement (ED Fest was successful, a few alumni returned).
 - 8. Vacancy in Middle School Math is being covered by the instructional coach.
- - 1. New STAR platform has been implemented which has targeted activities built in
 - 2. First Town Hall meeting for parents was held (Parents were asked what can Lamond do to make improvements)
 - 3. At the ELL & amp; SPED nights' parents were given activities they can do at home to support their children.

- 4. Early Childhood Summit was attended by all Early Childhood staff
- 5. School based security guard was hired for an additional layer of security
- 6. One SPED dedicated aide may need to be added based on IEP results
- 7. One dedicated aide needs to be added for a student who broke his femur
