SUMMARY: The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request by DC Wildflower Public Charter School (DC Wildflower PCS) to locate its facility at 913 55th St. NE in Ward 7.

DC Wildflower PCS received conditional approval on April 19, 2021 to establish a new public charter school. This approval is contingent on the school satisfying all the Board's conditions, which includes securing a facility. Pending its full charter approval, the school will begin operation in school year 2022-23 serving students in grades PK3 and PK4. At capacity, it will serve a total of 225 students in grades PK3 through 5.
