



**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comments on the proposed Charter Goals Policy. The COVID-19 Impact Policy expires on June 30, 2023,<sup>1</sup> and DC PCSB staff proposes the Charter Goals Policy to update and centralize the criteria for charter goal attainment through school year 2023 – 24.

**PUBLIC MEETINGS:** The public hearing will be on May 15, 2023 at 6:00 pm. The vote will be on June 26, 2023 at 6:00 pm. Please visit [www.dcpccb.org/events](http://www.dcpccb.org/events) to register to attend the meetings.

**HOW TO SUBMIT PUBLIC COMMENTS:** You may submit comments by any one of the methods listed below.<sup>2</sup>

1. Testify during the public meeting on May 15. To register, please visit <https://dcpccb.org/public-comment>. Click “Sign up to Testify at the Meeting,” then complete the form. Please note you must sign up no later than noon on May 15, 2023.
2. Submit a written comment on or before 11:59 pm the day before the public meeting via

3. Submit voicemail testimony by calling (202) 328-2660 and selecting option 2. You will have up to five minutes to record your testimony. All comments will be transcribed and made available to the public upon receipt.
