



**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on a request from Eagle Academy Public Charter School (Eagle Academy PCS) to amend its charter agreement by expanding to serve grades 4 and 5 beginning in school year (SY) 2024 – 25. The school submitted its request on May 16, 2023.<sup>1</sup>

Founded in SY 2003 – 24, Eagle Academy PCS educates 412 students in grades pre-kindergarten-3 (PK3) through 3 across two campuses in Wards 6 and 8. The school's mission is "to build the foundation for a promising future for all students in a rich, robust learning environment that fosters creativity and problem-solving abilities."

3. Submit voicemail testimony by calling (202) 328-2660 and selecting option 2. You will have up to five minutes to record your testimony. All comments will be transcribed and made available to the public upon receipt.
