

## Notice of Petition to Adopt Mergers and Acquisitions Policy Open for Public Comment

## Public Comment Accepted Until November 17, 2025

**SUMMARY:** The District of Columbia Public Charter School Board (DC PCSB) announces an opportunity for the public to submit comment on the newly proposed Mergers and Acquisitions Policy. As population forecasts for school-age children decline and city conditions change, DC PCSB must create the policies for thoughtful charter sector planning. This policy for mergers and acquisitions offers a set of pathways to support the sector's sustainability, efficiency, and quality.

Under the School Reform Act (SRA), the assets of a closing local education agency (LEA) or campus may be transferred to another LEA if that LEA agrees to enroll the closing school's students.<sup>2</sup> This policy explains how a merger or acquisition serves as the means for this transfer of assets.<sup>3</sup> To provide clarity and transparency to that process, the proposed policy seeks to:

- 1. Define mergers and acquisitions.
- 2. Set guiding principles to drive its evaluation of sector planning-related requests.<sup>4</sup>
- 3. Establish minimum eligibility criteria and a review process for three policy pathways: mergers, standard acquisitions, and emergency acquisitions.
