- Enrollment Enrollment is currently at 397. Movement of waiting list and currently enrolled students can and will continue until October 5, 2020. Schools across the city and DCSP are seeing lower enrollment. Mayor is now doing a push to get families to finish enrollment or start enrollment.
- Bridges re-opening plan Bridges will start school on August 31, 2020 doing 100% virtual instruction. If health indicators are good, Bridges is currently planning to start a hybrid instructional approach for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter starting on November 9. 2020.
- Legal matters All legal matters are moving forward as expected.
