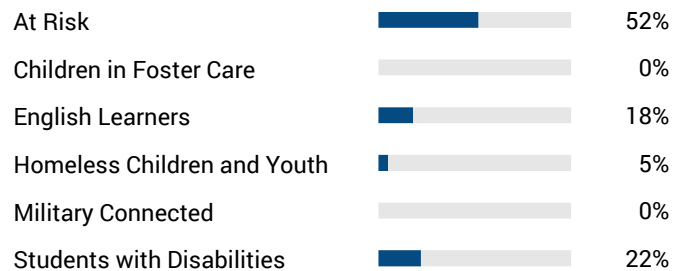
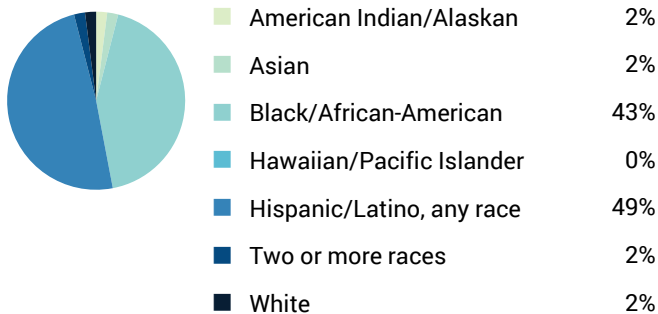
MESSAGE FROM THE SCHOOL
