

A Note from the School

Friendship PCS's mission is to provide a world-class education that motivates students to achieve high academic standards, enjoy learning, and develop as ethical, literate, well-rounded, and self-sufficient citizens who contribute actively to their communities. Technology Preparatory High (Tech Prep High) is a 9th-12th grade college preparatory school with a focus on the STEM fields of science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. High school students experience a rigorous, standards-based curriculum that prepares them for success in college and career. High school students can earn college credit and take Advanced Placement courses starting in 9th grade. Students travel abroad to conduct environmental projects. Tech Prep High graduated its first class of 30 seniors in 2015, and high school graduates to date have garnered nearly \$2 million in scholarships. Students are supported by Friendship Alumni Affairs staff while in college. For the 2017-18 school year, Friendship Tech Prep High was led by Mrs. Peggy Jones, Head of Schools, and Ms. Kun Ye Booth, Resident Principal.
