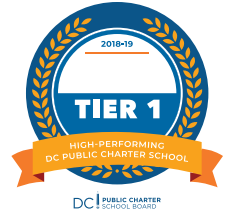

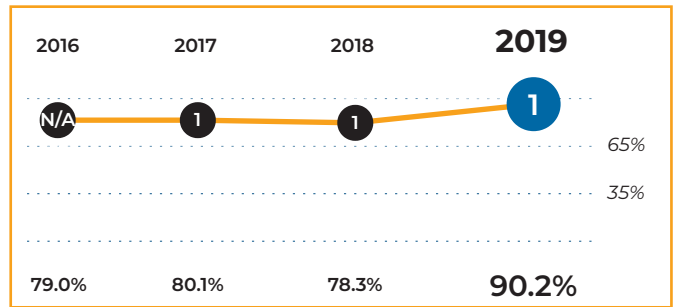
Note from the School

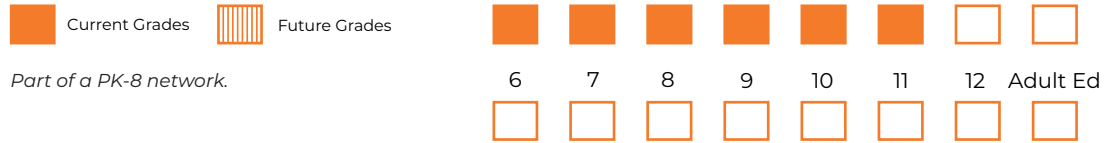

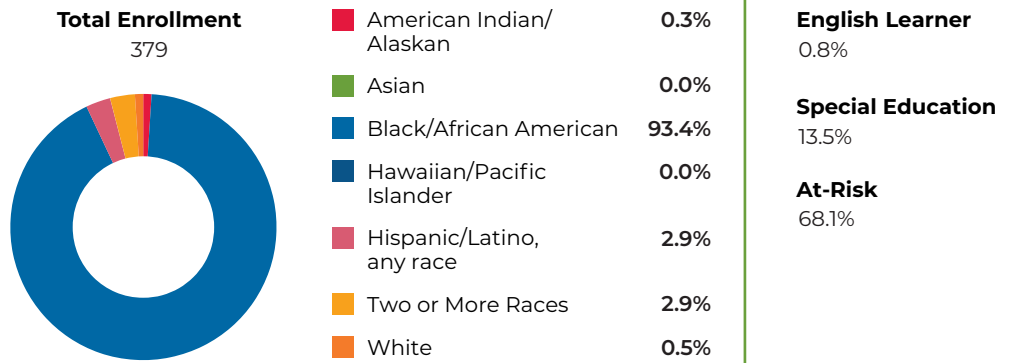
