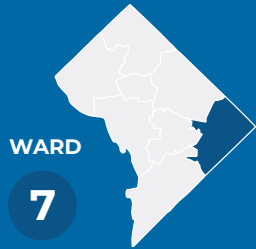

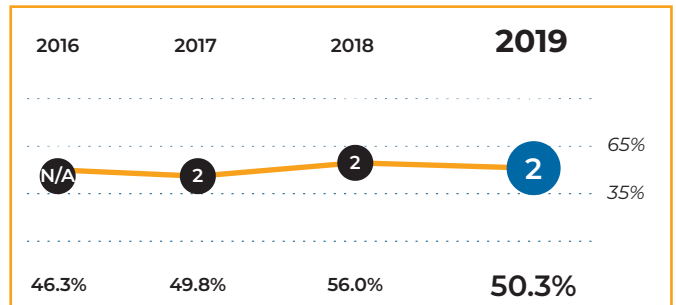
### Note from the School

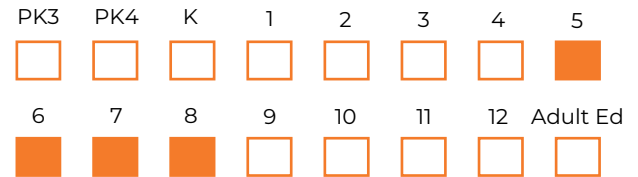

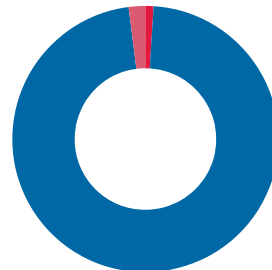
Current Grades (Solid Orange) Future Grades (Hatched Orange)

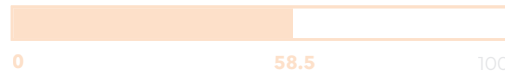
