

Note from the School

Over the past three years, National Prep improved some of its college and career readiness rates. We anticipated continued improvement, despite DC PCSB's decision to revoke our school's charter. The charter revocation decision had a considerable impact on the families we serve, and had an adverse effect on school climate. Families withdrew immediately after the revocation decision to secure their child's 2019-20 enrollment. This affected our mid-year withdrawal, re-enrollment, and 9th grade on-track rates. If not for this decision, we project the school's Performance Management Framework rates would have been higher.


