# **Appendix**

#### **Enrollment**

The student counts by grade level include all students ever enrolled in the District during school year 2017-2018. The enrollment percentages include all students ever enrolled in the District in grades PK3 to 12 during school year 2017-2018.

#### Attendance

In-Seat Attendance is the average percentage of students who attended school on a daily basis, calculated as Total Number of Days Present / Total Number of Days Enrolled. The rates provided in this report include all students enrolled in the District for at least ten instructional days in grades PK3 to 12 during school year 2017-2018.

#### Discipline

The Expulsion Rate refers to the percent of students ever enrolled who received an expulsion. The Out-of-School Suspension Rate refers to the percent of students ever enrolled who received an out-of-school suspension. Both rates include all students ever enrolled in the District during school year 2017-2018 (including Adult students).

#### **PARCC Achievement**

Student Achievement: Percent 3+ refers to the percent of students eligible to take the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) assessment or the Multi-State Alternative Assessment (MSAA) who scored a level of 3, 4, or 5 on the PARCC, or a level 3 or 4 on MSAA. Student Achievement: Percent 4+ refers to the percent of students eligible for the PARCC or MSAA who scored a level of 4 or 5 on the PARCC, or a level 3 or 4 on the MSAA. Please refer to the 2018 DC School Report Card and STAR Framework Technical Guide for additional detail.

#### **Student Growth**

The provided Student Growth Scores reflect the median value of the student growth percentiles among students who took the PARCC. Student growth percentiles measure students' growth between testing years compared to academically similar students across the PARCC Consortium. A student with a growth percentile of 50 outpaced 50% of her academically similar peers in terms of growth on PARCC between testing years. Students must have at least two years of PARCC data in order to receive a student growth percentile. Please refer to the 2018 DC School Report Card and STAR Framework Technical Guide for additional detail.

#### **Mid-Year Entries and Withdrawals**

The provided Entry and Withdrawal Rates reflect student movement between the Enrollment Audit Count Day and the end of May. The rates provided in this report include all students ever enrolled in the District in grades PK3 to 12 during school year 2017-2018.

#### Graduation

The provided Graduation Rates reflect rates published in the DC School Report Card, which can be found in the <u>2018 DC School Report Card and STAR Framework Data Files</u>. The High School STAR Framework includes the 4-Year and Extended Years Graduation Rates, while the Alternative STAR Framework includes 5-Year Graduation Rate only. The definitions for each type of graduation rate are:

> 4-Year Graduation Rate: The percent of students in the adjusted 9th grade cohort that graduate within four years; this is calculated as:

# of students in the denominator who graduated by SY 2017-18 # of students who were in 9th grade in SY 2014-15 + new students – exited students

> 5-Year Graduation Rate: The percent of students in the adjusted 9th grade cohort that graduate within five years; this is calculated as:

# of students in the denominator who graduated by SY 2017-18 # of students who were in 9th grade in SY 2013-14 + new students – exited students

Extended Years Graduation Rate: The number of students who graduate, regardless of the number of years that it takes, divided by the number of students in the four-year graduation cohort; unlike the 4-year and 5-year rates, students may be included in the numerator without being included in the denominator. This metric is designed to recognize schools that are successfully graduating off-track students, and is calculated as:

# of students who graduated by SY 2017-18, regardless of their first 9th grade year # of students who were in 9th grade in SY 2014-15 + new students – exited students
