High School and Young Adult Learning Center Campuses

New enrolling students must apply through MySchoolDC and be matched or accepted prior to the submission of additional registration documentation. Returning students enrolling at Maya Angelou Public Charter High School Campus must apply directly with the school by contacting the Enrollment Manager.

New and returning students who are accepted must submit the online registration forms using PowerSchool Enrollment Express and E-Collect Forms. Student families must submit supporting documentation below in person to their enrolling school to register for the upcoming school year.

All students at the Young Adult Learning Center must apply directly with the school. MySchoolDC is not available for the Young Adult Learning Center.

- DC Oral Health Assessment Form Completed by Dental Provider
- HPV Vaccine Opt-Out Form [If Applicable]
- Medical or Religious Immunization Opt-Out Forms (obtained from DC Health)

New students only:

- Identification Information:
 - Birth Certificate (or another document that establishes student age)
 - Government issued ID of parent or legal guardian (or some other valid form of photo identification)
 - Proof of legal guardianship [If applicable]
- School History Documents
 - For all new 9th graders: A final 8th grade report card that states that the student is “promoted”.
 - For all other students: All high school transcripts
